POLICY TITLE: Basis of Authority

POLICY NUMBER: 1005

The Board of Commissioners is the legislative body and unit of authority within the District. Power is centralized in the appointed Board collectively and not in an individual Commissioner. Apart from his/her normal function as a part of this unit, Commissioners have no individual authority. As individuals, Commissioners may not commit the District to any policy, act, or expenditure.

1005.2 Commissioners do not represent any fractional segment of the community but are, rather, a part of the body that represents and acts for the community as a whole. Routine matters concerning the operational aspects of the District are delegated to District staff members.
